






#### In Africa, potato & sweetpotato complement each other

# As population density increases, farmers turn towards crops with high energy outputs per unit land per unit time



Given that they are vegetatively propagated, both crops face bottlenecks in their seed systems that scientists are tackling





Both are nutritious, especially in the boiled/steamed form that dominates in SSA, but both have image problems....

Major difference: post-harvest use well developed in potato with an active private sector; sweetpotato still seen as a food security crop.






