

SPHI indicator categories



- SPHI indicators fall into 2 broad categories of goals:
 - Agriculture
 - Nutrition

- Targets:
 - Improve income by 15%
 - Improve diet quality by 20%

Indicators we track



- 1. Vine dissemination
- # of households receiving
 OFSP vines

- Disaggregated by:
 - Presence if U5 year
 - Gender of household head





Indicators tracked...



- 2. Production
- Mean household production (kg/hhd) SP, OFSP
 - √ Value of production (US \$)
- 3. Mean household sales
 - Sweetpotato, OFSP
 - Kg/household
 - Value (\$)/household
- % of households selling SP, OFSP



Indicators tracked...

- 4. Improvement in diet quality
- ✓ Dietary diversity
 - Household >> HDD
 - Young child (Individual) >> CDD
 - Woman >> MDD-W
- ✓ Frequency of Vit A consumption
