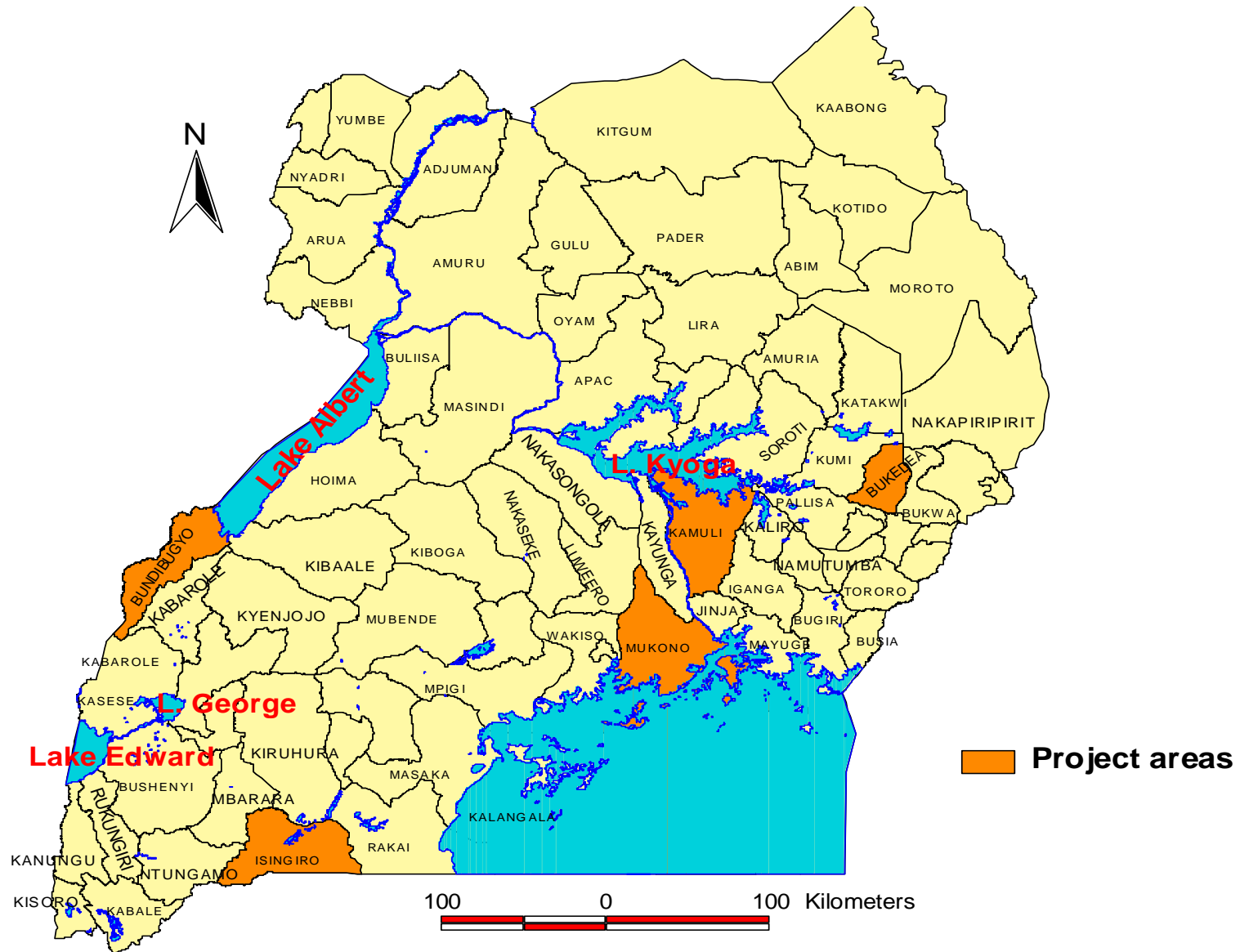

Geographical coverage 2006-2010



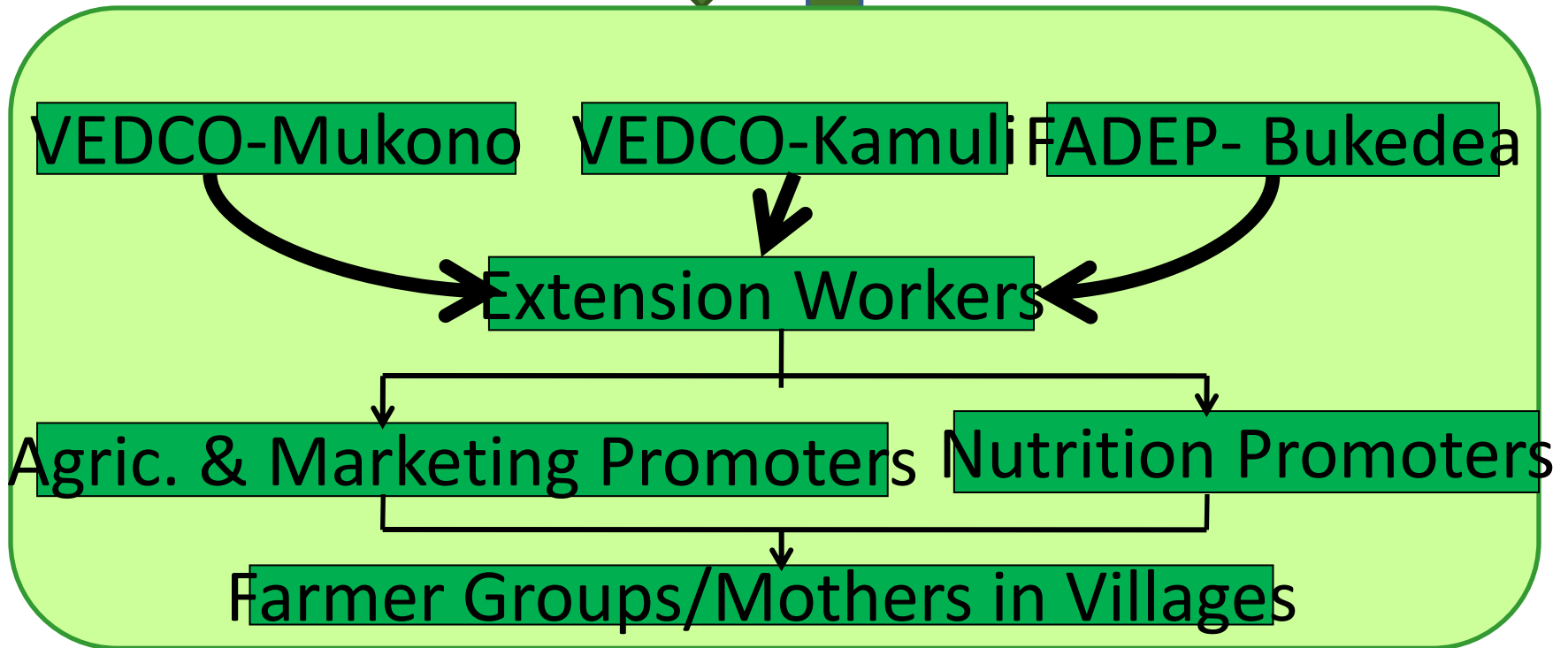

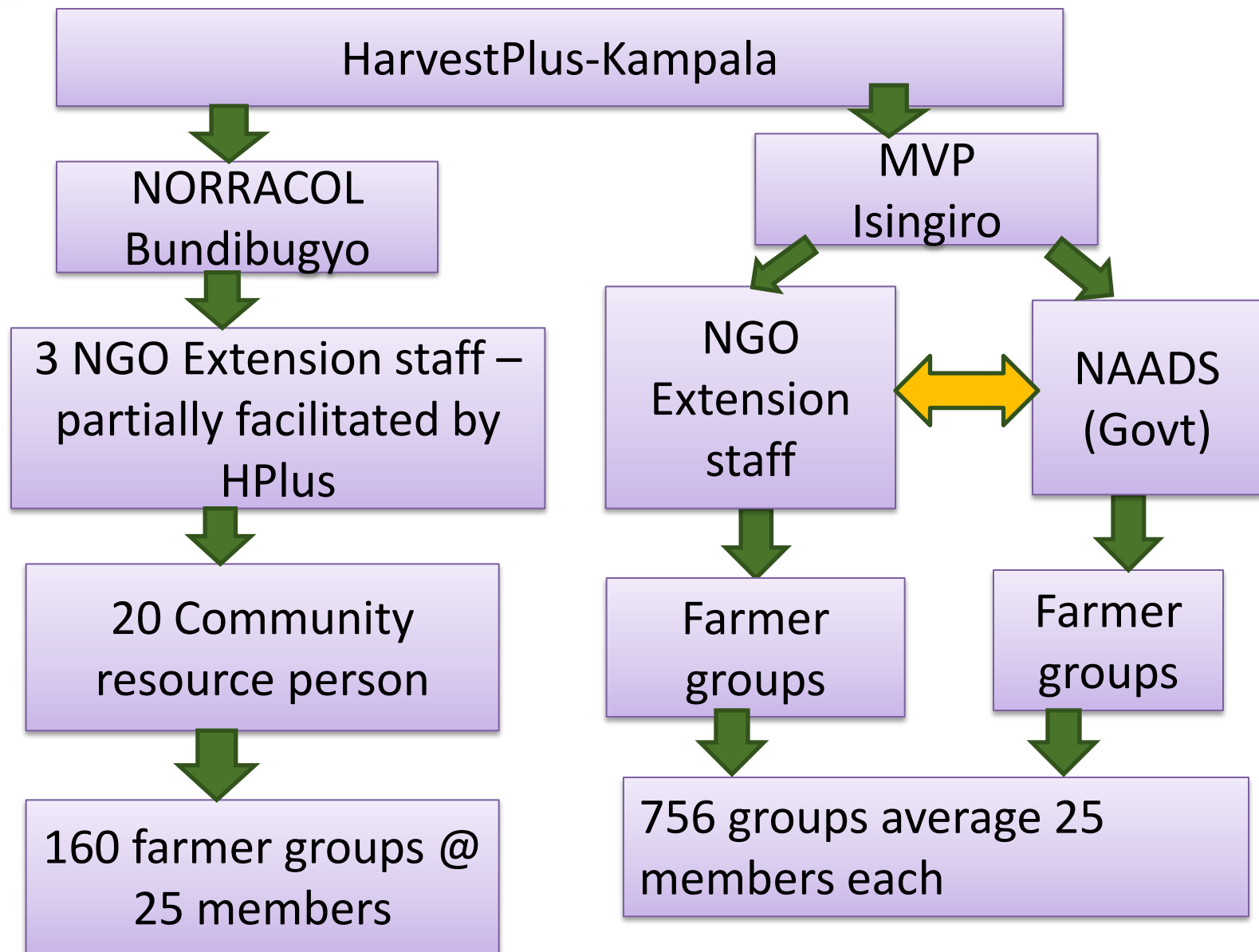

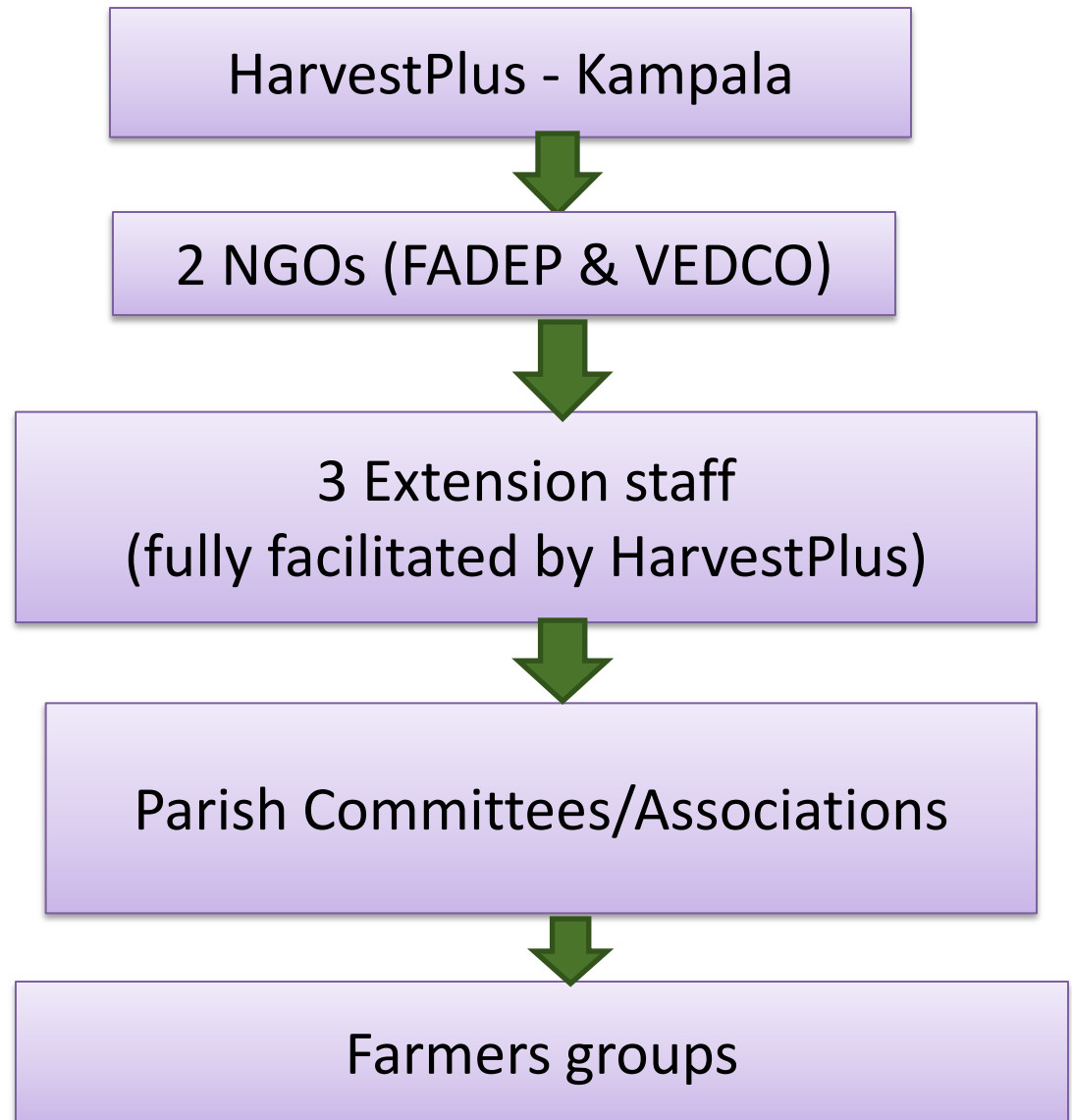
Implementation in new districts

Target: Direct Beneficiaries – 75,000 over 5 years;

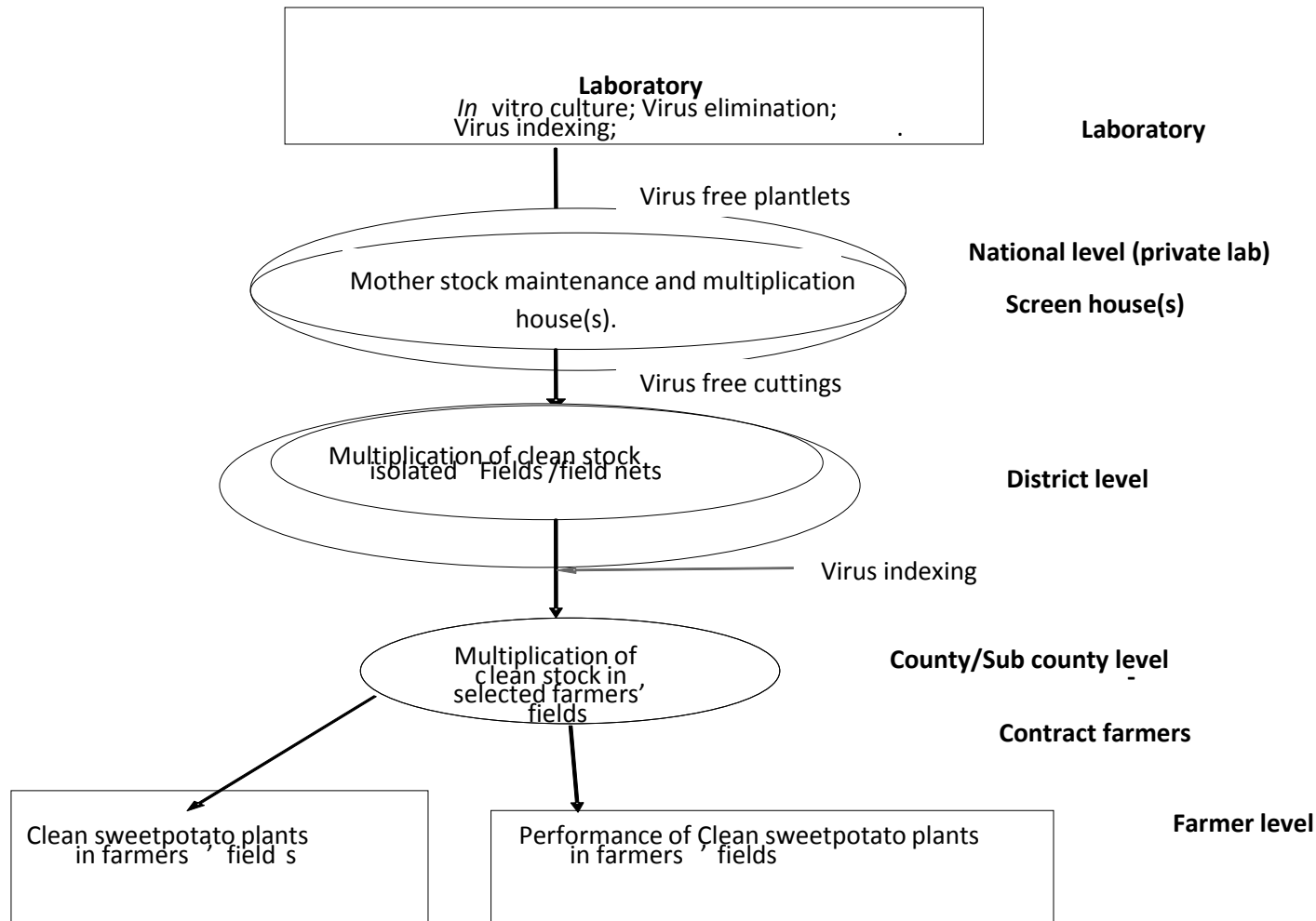
Directly influenced: 150,000; total 225,000
