Stakeholders' Response



- Seed system workshop Held at Bungoma
- Pre-basic seed price previously at 50 ksh (0.5 USD) per 30 cm cutting-based on market price used by CIP
Stakeholders: Price on the higher side – affecting cost of value chain. Review of costing requested.
- Real costing activity led to pricing at ksh 20 - 35 (USD 0.2 - 0.35) for institutions and Ksh 10 – 20 (0.1 – 0.2 USD) for multipliers.
Stakeholders: Price affordable and suitable for sustained value chain
