

Major African Field Crops Area Growth 1995-2017






- Strong recovery after the 2015 drop

- rate of area expansion















What is driving Uganda trends? (production in Tons)


















Progress in vine delivery: Beneficiaries reached - July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019






Individual beneficiaries reached: July 1, 2017- June 30, 2019






Direct/indirect beneficiaries reached: June 1, 2017 – July 30, 2019






Beneficiary – by gender






HH reached, by partner/project (July 2018-June 2019)




Vine multipliers improving vine access: 2019 Phone update






Vine Multiplier Composition, by type




